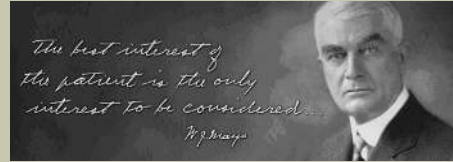

ACS Dues and Income

- **Dues**
 - Account for approx. **23%** of ACS income
 - **Support** ongoing programs :
The *Bulletin*, Advisory Councils, Governors, committees, NSQIP, Clinical Congress, etc. . . .
- **Income**
 - Charges for hospital users of Quality and Accreditation Programs.
 - Product sales
 - Exhibitor fees at Clinical Congress
 - **5% from endowment**

- Surgeon Specific Registry

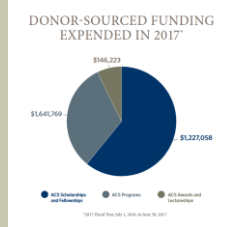


And . . .

Funding Needs

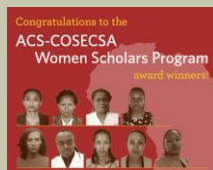
- Breast Staging Calculator

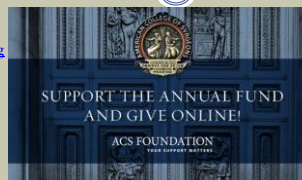
